PG&E / PALO ALTO UTILITES INSTRUCTIONS

NOR CAL Fumigation arranges the gas **turn off** on the morning of the fumigation with your utility company and they will arrive between 8am-12noon. *You do not need to meet them at this time but make sure they have access to the meter by having the gates unlocked by 8am. ONLY THE GAS WILL BE TURNED OFF.*

The electricity remains on and is needed to complete our work. **You, the account holder will need to call and schedule the turn on service.** The reason you need to do this is because they need to go inside the home to re-light the pilots. Make sure this is arranged at least 3-5 days in advance of your desired re-entry date (see above date). You can have them turn on your gas as early as 5pm on the safe for re-entry date. Make sure to save the **SAFE FOR RE-ENTRY SIGN** that will be posted on your property by the fumigator. The Utility company requires this sign to restore your gas. You may receive an automated call from your Utility Company in regards to the turn off appointment we scheduled. Please don't cancel this appointment.

- **PG&E Customers:** PG&E does not schedule service appointments on Sundays or Holidays, and may only schedule evening turn on appointments in select cities.
- **Palo Alto Utility Customers:** Palo Alto Utilities does not schedule appointments on Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays.
- **Propane Customers:** Propane tanks need to be turned off prior to our arrival
- **Gates:** Unlock any and all gates on the property by 8am on your fumigation day. Padlocks on gates must be removed. If the property has an electric gate or is in a gated community, we must be provided with a gate code or key. If the utility company arrives at a property and the gates are locked, they may leave without giving notice and without completing the turn off. This can result in your fumigation being delayed
- **Arrival Times:** Fumigation schedules are made daily each morning. The fumigation team can arrive anytime from 8am to 5pm or later. You can contact our office at 8am the day of to get an approximate time of arrival. Schedules are subject to change if any issues should arise.
- **Neighbors:** As a courtesy, please notify your neighbors of your fumigation date so that they can protect their outdoor cats. If they have any concerns, please feel free to give them our contact number so we can answer any questions they may have.
- **Weather:** In case of rain or strong winds your fumigation can be postponed.
- **Person of Contact:** Makes sure we have a good contact person throughout entire fumigation process to aid in any issues.

Please be advised that some damage may occur to items on or around your property. Our trained crew uses various measures to prevent damages, however some are unavoidable with completing the necessary work.

Exterior Preparation Required:

It's the owner's responsibility to pull back all ground cover (tanbark, rocks, vegetation etc.) and to cut back all plant life at least 12 inches from the structure to prevent being covered by the tarp and damaged. Any climbing vines/plants/ trellises must be pulled away as well. We need bare soil around the perimeter to create a seal. Make sure to water the surrounding soil the morning of your fumigation day.

It is the owner's responsibility to move away all potted plants, decorative items, outdoor furniture, wind chimes, etc. These personal items may get damaged in the process of fumigating if left in the work area.

TV Antennas may need to be removed to perform the fumigation. Satellite dishes will be wrapped around so they do not need to be removed. Nor Cal assumes no responsibility for any damages to antenna and or dish or for realignment of satellite dish

Fences that abut the structure will need to be detached. Fences with gates do not need to be detached. Nor Cal assumes no responsibility for damage to fence boards

Clear driveways of vehicles, RV'S, boats etc. Remove exterior lighting & bulbs that would be in close contact of our tarps.

Please DO NOT paint and or stain hardwood floors prior to fumigation. If you plan on doing so make sure it is completely dry prior to the fumigation.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES CAN ANYONE ENTER THE BUILDING UNTIL THE FUMIGATION COMPANY'S NOTICE IS POSTED GIVING THE TIME AND DATE FOR SAFE RE-ENTRY.

“State law requires that you be given the following information: CAUTION-PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS. Structural pest control companies are registered and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board and apply pesticides which are registered and approved for used by the California Department of Pesticide Regulation and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the State finds that based on existing scientific evidence there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized.

If within 24 hours you experience symptoms of dizziness, headache, nausea, reduced awareness, slowed movement, garbled speech or difficulty in breathing, leave the structure immediately and seek medical attention by contacting your physician or Poison Control Center (800) 876-4766 and notify your pest control company. The warning agent, Chloropicrin, can cause symptoms of tearing, respiratory distress and vomiting. Entry into the space during fumigation can be fatal.

The following items are important to ensure that NOR CAL Fumigation, INC. safely performs a fumigation according to federal laws and regulations in a timely manner.

- ✓ Owners must confirm there is **electricity** and **water at the property** during the fumigation process.
- ✓ Make sure fumigation team has keys to your home as well as access to all other detached structures on the property throughout the entire fumigation process (sheds, cottages, pool house, etc.). This is due to possible conduits on the property. We recommend vehicles be removed from inside garages and carports. If vehicles remain, they must be unlocked, windows down, trunk and glove compartment opened.
- ✓ All **persons, domestic animals, pets (this includes fish) and desirable growing plants MUST be removed from the home.**
Interior Preparation Required:
- ✓ All **food, medicine (including tobacco products) and pet feed** items that are not factory sealed in hard plastic, metal or glass jars must be removed from the entire structure being fumigated. If you wish to keep food items in the refrigerator or structure, you may, **ONLY** if double bagged and sealed properly in Nylofume bags (a special material used to safely protect items from gas, which only may be purchased from authorized distributors such as your fumigation or termite companies). Food items and or medicines found in the home by our lead fumigator that isn't properly bagged will be discarded at occupants' expense. Wine can remain in the home if unopened with original cork and stored on its side. **BAGS CAN BE PURCHASED AT OUR OFFICE.**
- ✓ Any **mattresses** or pillows with plastic coverings or protectors either need to be removed entirely, or the plastic must be removed to prevent any trapped gasses. Baby mattresses must be removed.
- ✓ Unseal and unstack boxes. This is to prevent gas from being trapped and possibly delaying your re-entry.
- ✓ To ensure complete gas circulation and ventilation, we request that you open all drawers, cabinets, safes, closet doors etc. Please be aware that any previously closed compartments may be left open by the fumigator for aeration purposes.
- ✓ We must have access to all windows. Please clear these areas of personal belongings and open blinds and/or drapes.
- ✓ Clear items in the way of your attic and subarea access. We are required to keep both accesses opened during the fumigation for proper circulation of the gas.
- ✓ Extinguish all flames, including pilot lights and turn off all heating elements. Turn off automatic switch controls such as sprinklers, security lights, house alarms, heating and air conditioning units.
- ✓ Pots, dishes and eating utensils do not need to be removed from the home or washed after the fumigation is complete. Cosmetics and lotions do not need to be removed. Toothpaste and mouthwash don't need to be removed.

NOR CAL fumigation and Coastal Termite & Pest Control does not provide onsite security throughout the fumigation process. We recommend you hire onsite security if you are concerned about vandalism or burglary. Make sure to remove any valuable items from the house (cash, jewelry, coins, etc.)

What to bag or remove

YES, bag or remove these items:

Medicine, tobacco, vitamins and other ingestible pills, supplements and lozenges if not sealed in glass, plastic or metal jars or cans with the original manufacturer's seal intact



Pet food and animal feed in bags and boxes



Any food, feed, drugs and medicines if not sealed in glass, plastic or metal bottles, jars or cans with the original manufacturer's airtight seal intact



Chips, pasta, bread, cereals, rice, cookies, crackers and any other items packaged in plastic, paper or cardboard bags or boxes, even if they have never been opened



Beverages, snacks, sauces, drugs, medicines or other items in metallic foil-lined containers such as pouches, boxes or blister packs



Anything in resealable containers, including plastic containers, such as milk, butter, sour cream and cottage cheese



Eggs, fruits, vegetables and any other forms of produce



Don't forget about these items:

- Any food, feed, drugs, tobacco products and medicinals NOT sealed in glass, plastic or metal bottles, jars or cans with the original manufacturer's airtight seal intact.
- Spices without their original manufacturer's airtight seal intact.



Please follow these instructions carefully

1.

While bags are still empty, place one inside another. Double-bagging helps ensure effective protection.



2.

Place items inside the inner bag. Do NOT overfill — leave clearance on top for adequate closure of the bags.



3.

Twist the top of the inner bag.



4.

Fold once and secure the fold in place by using tape or a twist tie.



5.

Repeat Steps 3 and 4 with the outer bag.



6.

Check the seal by pressing gently against the sides of the bag and listening for air leaks. No air should be able to escape.

Fact Sheet For Vikane® Gas Fumigant (Sulfuryl Fluoride)

Vikane® Gas Fumigant

In the interest of Douglas Products' commitment to product stewardship, this fact sheet is intended to provide basic information about the product and how it is used. If you have specific questions about your fumigation, refer to documents provided by the fumigator or call the fumigator listed on the warning signs posted on your structure. If you have questions about Vikane gas fumigant (the fumigant used) or the procedures described, call the Douglas Products Customer Information Center at 844-8VIKANE (844-884-5263).

Why Buildings Are Fumigated

Insects that feed or tunnel into wood can seriously damage houses, apartments, and other dwellings or structures. Each year termites or other wood destroying insects damage more than 5 million homes. Other pests, such as bed bugs, may be dispersed throughout rooms and can be difficult to locate and control quickly and completely. Depending on the extent or location of the infestation, fumigation is the only total control method proven to eliminate certain infestations of wood destroying insects, bed bugs, and other structure-infesting pests.

How Buildings Are Fumigated

Because Vikane is a gas, prior to fumigation, the structure is completely sealed. This serves to contain Vikane in the building so it can penetrate wood and building contents to thoroughly eliminate the pests. Depending on the construction of the building, the doors and windows may be sealed with tape and a plastic sheet, or the structure may be covered with a tarp. The building will remain sealed for 2-72 hours depending on the specifics of the job. Warning signs are posted around the building notifying people to keep out.

After the fumigation period is completed, a professional fumigator will aerate the structure using fans for a prescribed aeration period. Once the dwelling has been thoroughly aerated, the fumigator is required to measure the level of any fumigant remaining in the living space to ensure it is below the EPA approved concentration for reentry by the occupants.

Extremely low levels of fumigant can remain for a short period of time in dead air spaces between walls and inside cabinets as well as porous materials such as furniture. The small amount of fumigant in these areas will continue to dissipate for a few hours after the fumigation but at levels well below the established safe reentry concentration. Your building will not be cleared for reoccupancy until it is safe to enter. The fumigator will post a notice on your building indicating the day and time for reentry. Structures can be occupied only when the concentration is 1 part per million or less (this represents a margin of safety – laboratory animals have been exposed to 100 parts per million for 2 weeks with no adverse effects). Because Vikane is a true gas and not a vapor, aeration is rapid. Recent studies demonstrated that in most structures levels are less than 1 part per million after the prescribed aeration period and have no detectable levels of Vikane within 24 hours after the start of aeration.

Sulfuryl fluoride is a colorless, odorless gas, so a warning agent is added to the building that causes watery eyes and a scratchy throat. If you experience these symptoms in a structure that has been recently fumigated, you should leave immediately and call the pest control company to have your building retested.

Sulfuryl Fluoride (Potential Health Risks From Overexposure)

Sulfuryl fluoride is a gas that can potentially enter your body only through inhalation. Because it is a gas, it does not stay on dry surfaces; therefore, there is no exposure from touching treated surfaces.

Nervous System And Respiratory Irritation

Overexposure to high levels of sulfuryl fluoride can result in nose and throat irritation and nausea. At high concentrations (such as those used during the fumigation) it can cause excess fluid in the lungs, sleepiness, pneumonia, and convulsions. These symptoms would be expected to appear within 8 hours after such an exposure. In the unlikely event you experience these symptoms in the building that has been recently fumigated, you should leave immediately. Consult your physician and call the pest control company to have your building retested.

Additional Studies

Sulfuryl fluoride has not been shown to cause birth defects in pregnant animals exposed under experimental conditions. In addition, current studies have demonstrated there are not mutagenic or genotoxic effects caused by exposure to sulfuryl fluoride.

Safety Precautions And Homeowner Preparation

- Discuss the treatment program in advance with your pest control company so you fully understand what will be done and what you need to do.
- Carefully follow the instructions you are given about what items you are to remove from your building.
- Stay out of the treated building until it is cleared by your pest control company for reentry.
- If you are interested or concerned, you should ask your pest control company to show the records of how your building was aerated before it was cleared for reentry.
- You may wish to increase ventilation by opening doors and windows.
